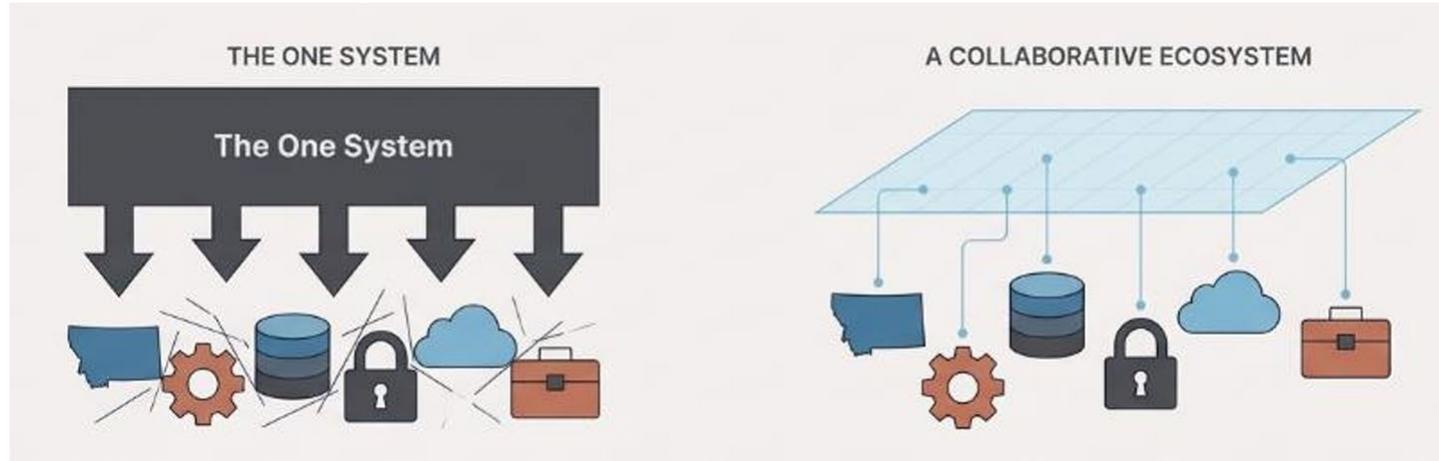
## What is NODE/INODE?

---

- » National Operations Digital Environment
- » Interstate National Operations Digital Environment
  - A connected, interoperable digital ecosystem for nationwide situational awareness and operational enhancement
  - Shared resources – tools/analytics, data validation, system health monitoring, etc
  - Regional/National traffic insights
  - Linking federal, state, and local transportation systems
- » Purpose
  - Improve safety, mobility, reliability, and resilience
  - Performance driven
  - Enable situational awareness and coordinated response across cities, counties, states, regions



# A New Way to Collaborate



- » States maintain ownership of their systems
  - No federal repository
  - States remain the authoritative source and operators of their systems
  - Can continue to invest in the technologies and tools they need
- » Supports standards coexistence
  - There is no single magical standard – there will always be a mix
- » Leverages innovation from private sector and academia
  - A monolithic system stifles market-driven solutions



# The Challenges

## » Discovery

- Finding relevant data across thousands of jurisdictions and vendors is hard

## » Trust

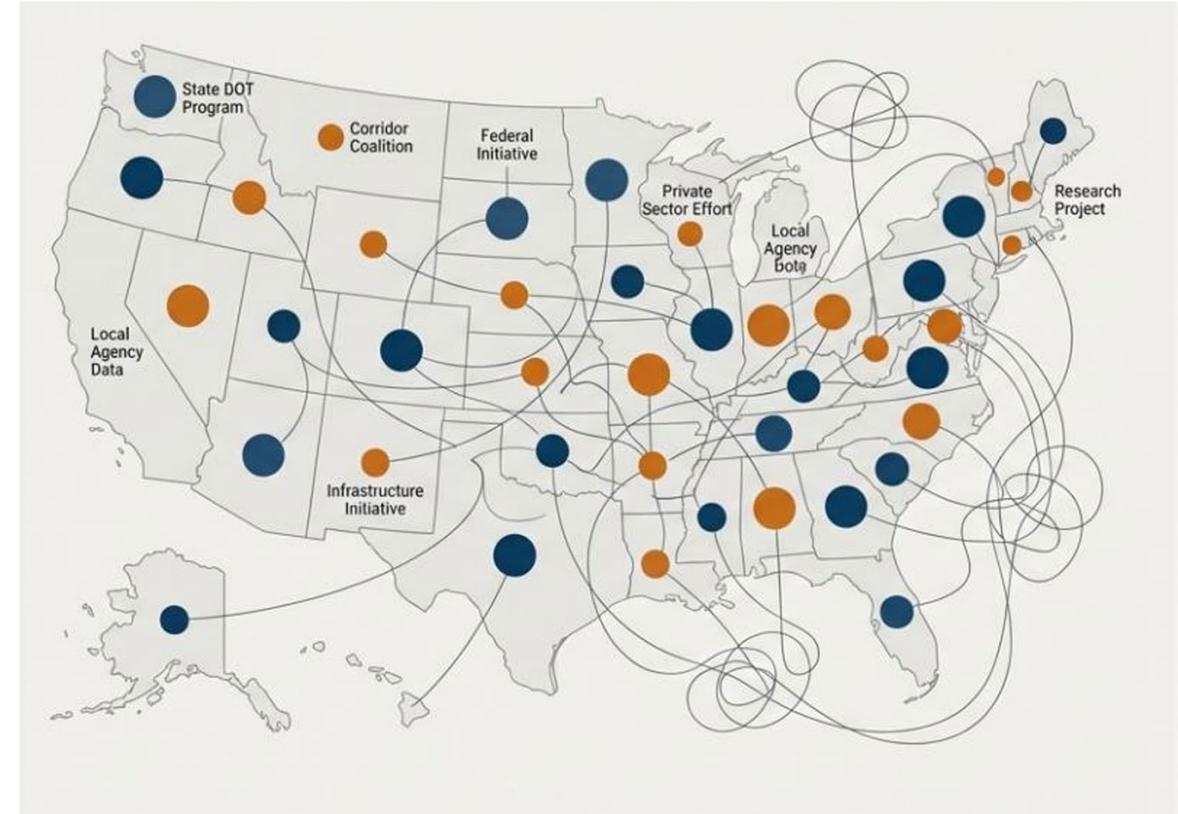
- No consistent way to assess data quality or standards compliance before committing resources
- Privacy concerns with CV data

## » Scalability

- Service providers often have to build custom integrations for every customer

## » Innovation

- Good innovation stays siloed instead of benefitting the greater community





# Clarifying Scope

NODE IS...	NODE IS NOT...
✓ A collaborative platform	x A command-and-control system to rule them all
✓ A set of shared utilities (e.g., data validation)	x A replacement for existing tools or systems
✓ An enabler of data and tool marketplaces	x A creator of new bureaucracies
✓ A federated framework where you can control your data	x A central database that holds all data
✓ State led, federally supported, and industry inclusive	x A top-down federal mandate or a federally owned product

## » Operational Benefits

- Better incident detection and response
- Improved traffic signal timing and congestion management
- Access to regional and national traffic insights

## » Resource Efficiency

- Shared tools – reduce duplication of systems
- Data-driven decisions improve ROI
- Supports smaller agencies with limited IT/ITS staff

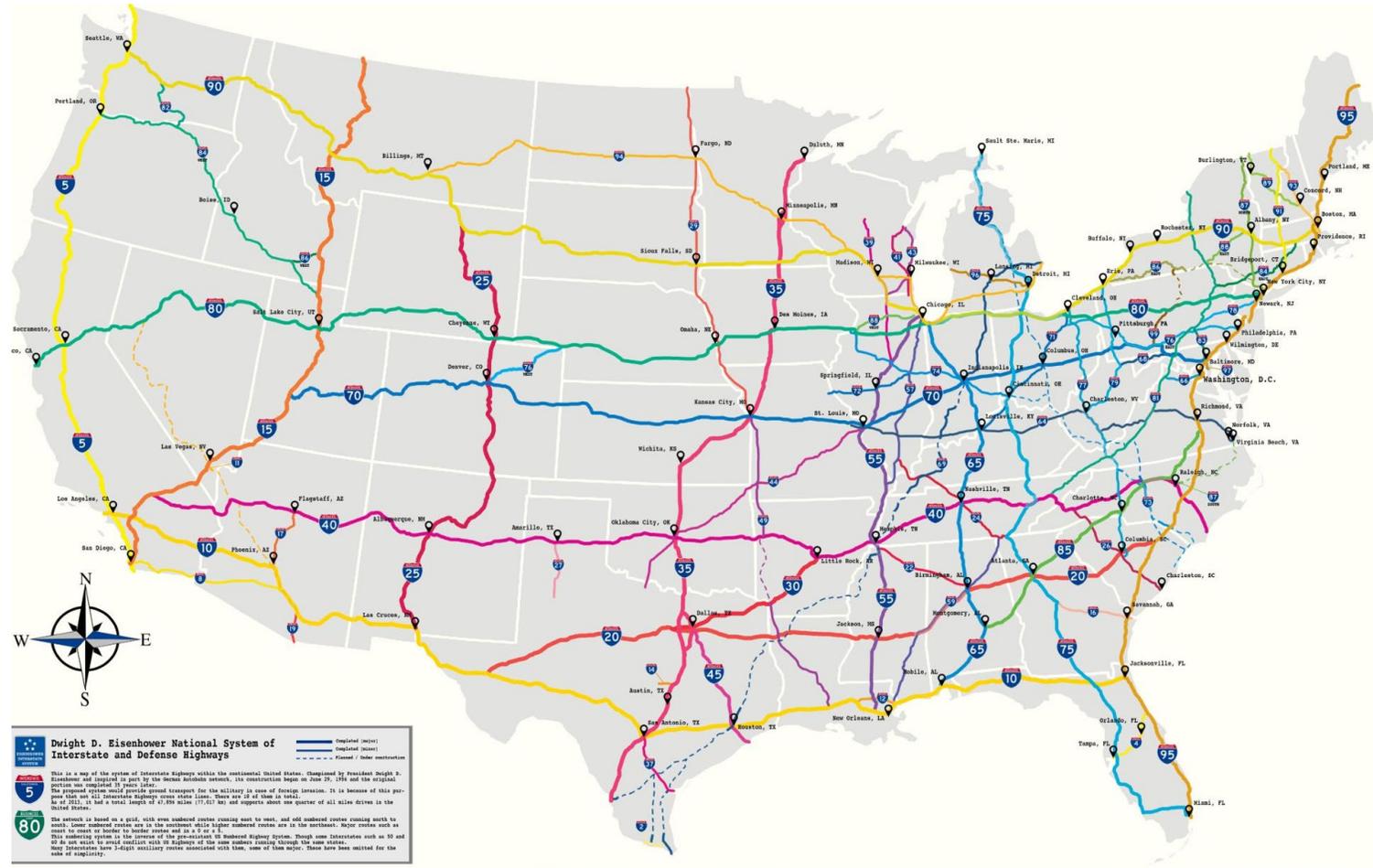
## » Enhanced Coordination

- Improved communication/collaboration with neighboring jurisdictions
- Better integration with state DOTs and emergency responders
