### Safety & Security

Provide a safe and secure transportation system for all users

- Eliminate the rate and occurrence of transportation system fatalities, injuries, and crashes with high emphasis on the most vulnerable users 100%
- Provide infrastructure and services to help prepare for, respond to, and recover from emergencies 90%
- Prevent and mitigate transportation-related security risks 95%
- Improve emergency response and incident clearance times 95%
- Increase the resiliency of infrastructure to risks, including extreme weather and other environmental conditions 98%



### Reliability & Performance

Leverage innovative solutions to optimize system performance

- Improve travel time reliability on the transportation system 98%
- Enhance and expand the region's ITS, adaptive and actively managed traffic systems 95%
- Reduce travel time per capita (peak and off-peak travel times) 93%
- Improve average transit on-time performance (bus and rail) 93%
- Maintain roadway level of service (LOS) 85%
- Adapt transportation infrastructure and technologies to meet changing traveler needs and desires 93%



### **Access & Connectivity**

Enhance communities and lives through improved access to opportunities


- Increase transit system frequency 95%
- Improve housing and employment access to high-frequency transit 95%
- Improve access to essential services across all modes of transportation 95%
- Reduce per capita vehicle miles traveled 95%
- Increase ridership on public transportation 98%
- Reduce the reliance on single-occupant vehicle travel 95%
- Plan and develop transportation systems that reflect regional and community values 93%



### **Health & Environment**

Protect and preserve our region's public health and environmentally sensitive areas

- Provide transportation solutions that contribute to improved public health 98%
- Expand conservation lands and minimize land consumption for future development 93%
- Increase population/employment densities and mix of land uses 93%
- Reduce per capita related air quality pollutants and greenhouse gas emissions 98%
- Reduce adverse health impacts associated with physical inactivity 93%
- Plan and develop transportation systems in a manner that protects and restores the function and character of the natural environment and avoids or minimizes adverse environmental impacts 98%
- Reduce transportation system impacts caused by stormwater issues and flooding 98%
- Prevent disproportionate adverse effects of transportation projects on minority and low-income communities 98%



### Investment & Economy

Support economic prosperity through strategic transportation investment

- Meet Exceed industry, state, and national standards for infrastructure and asset quality, condition, and performance for all public transportation infrastructure 85%
- Reduce per capita delay for residents, visitors, and businesses 95%
- Increase affordability for transportation and housing choices 93%
- Improve transportation experience for visitors and supportiveindustry workers 100%
- Increase the number of skilled workers in Central Florida's transportation-related industries 95%
- Promote transportation projects that expand and enhance economic prosperity 100%
