Developing Collective Priorities

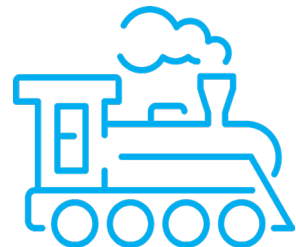
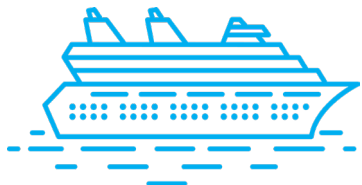
Each year, the Central Florida MPO Alliance develops and approves a Regional List of Priority Projects.



The Project Categories

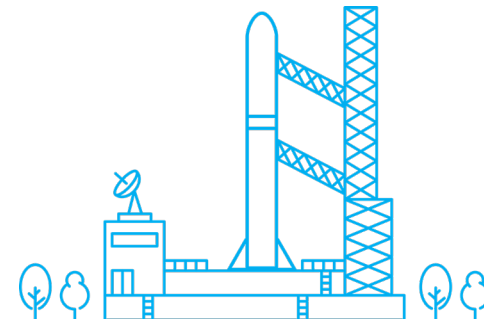
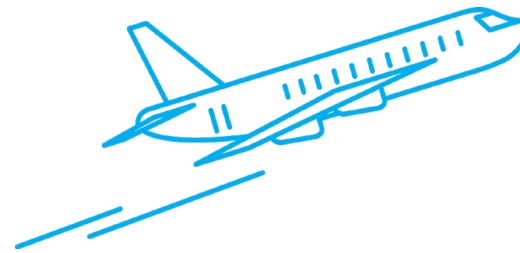
- **Transportation Regional Incentive Program (TRIP)**

- Serve national, statewide or regional functions
- Priority given for connectivity to the SIS
- Roadways and public transportation
- State matching funds up to 50%
- Incentive to local governments and private sector to leverage investments



- **Strategic Intermodal System (SIS)**

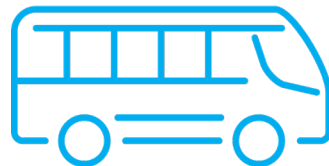
- Highest priority network for capacity
- Interregional, interstate, and international travel
- Hubs, Corridors, Intermodal Connectors and Military Access Facilities



The Project Categories

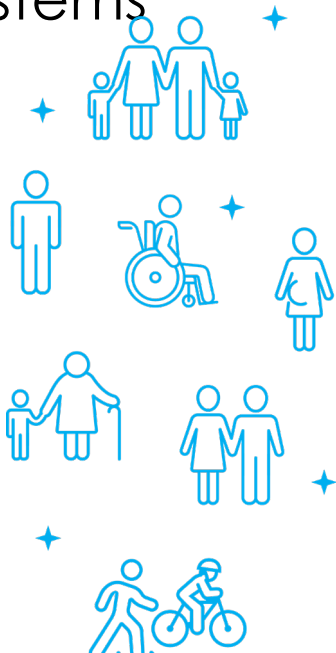
- **SUNTrails Program / Regional Trails**

- Coast to Coast (Tier 1)
- St. Johns River-to-Sea Loop (Tier 2)
- Local Trails (Tier 3)
- Aligned with Office of Greenways and Trails (OGT) System Plans
- Connects populations and attractions / supports eco-tourism



- **Regional Transit**

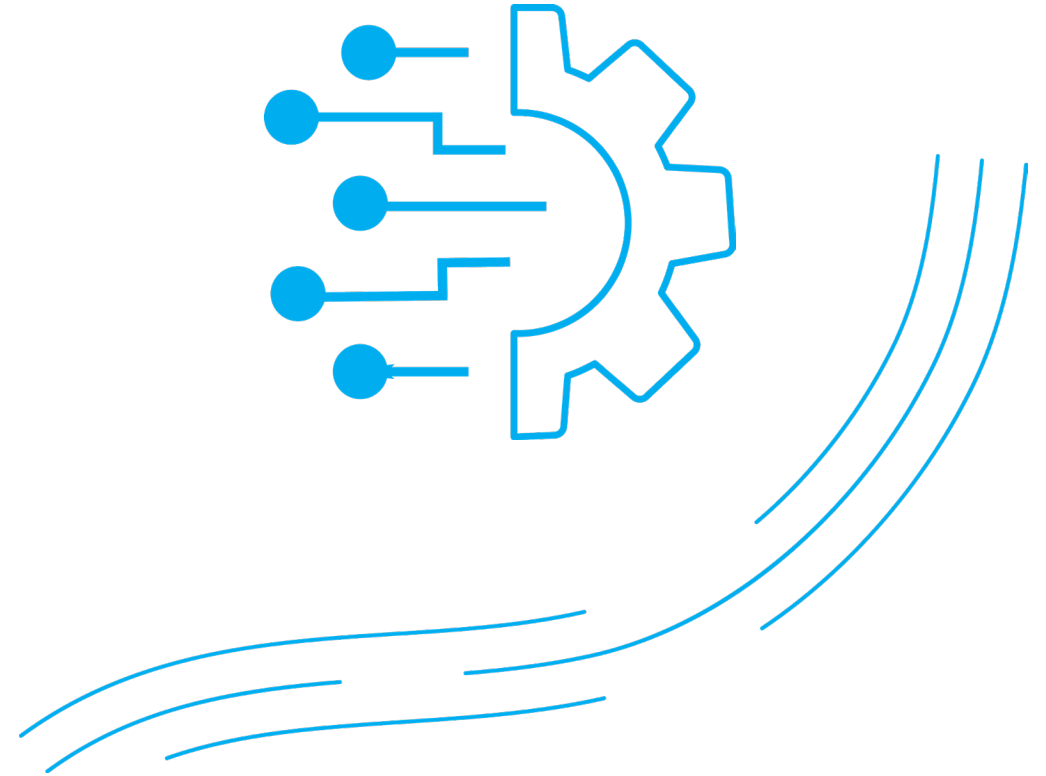
- Cross county lines and MPO boundaries
- Mass transit and connections to commuter / passenger rail systems



The Project Categories

- **Transportation Systems Management and Operations (TSMO)**

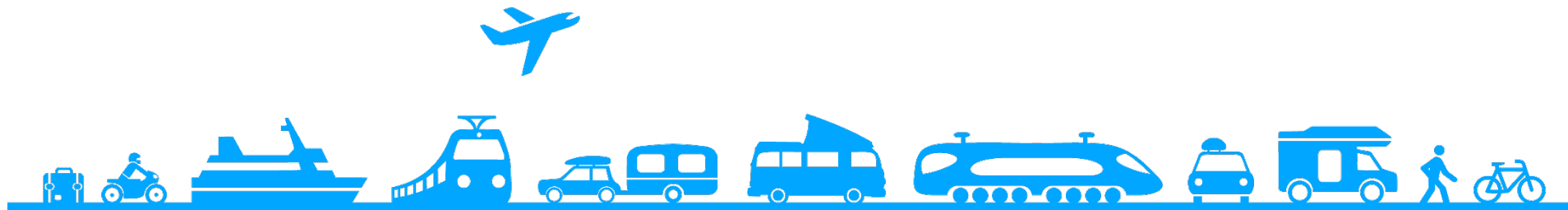
- Integrated strategies that use technology and real-time operational procedures
- Maximize efficiency, safety, and utility
- Consistent with the Strategic Intermodal System (SIS)
- Provides connectivity to SIS corridors, hubs, or connectors
- A component of an Integrated Corridor Management System (ICMS)
- Allows for bundling projects and/or integrated strategies



Direction and Process Timeline

MPO Directors met on March 26, 2026, to discuss:

- Review project categories
- Streamlining the Regional List
- Ensure alignment with regional significance parameters (SIS, major arterials, proximity to airports/seaports, etc).
- Development of a concise one-page flyer (shortlist) of top 3 priority projects for each MPO

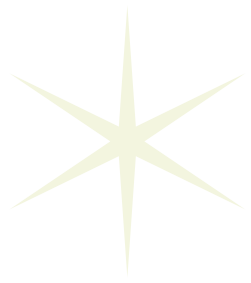


Things To Keep In Mind
