National Performance Management Measures for Highway Safety Improvement Program

WHEREAS, the Orlando Urbanized Area Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO), d.b.a. MetroPlan Orlando, is the duly designated and constituted body responsible for carrying out the urban transportation planning and programming process for the Orlando Urbanized Area, including the Transportation Improvement Program; and

WHEREAS, the Fixing Americas Surface Transportation Act, continues the Moving Ahead for Progress in the 21st Century's overall performance management approach, requires state Departments of Transportation to establish performance measures in a number of areas, including setting targets; and

WHEREAS, MetroPlan Orlando wishes to establish its safety targets consistent with those of the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT); and agrees to work with the State and safety stakeholders to address areas of concern for fatalities and serious injuries within the metropolitan planning area; and

WHEREAS, MetroPlan Orlando will coordinate with the State to integrate the safety performance measures and Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP) targets into the necessary planning processes and documents;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the MetroPlan Orlando Board that it supports the Florida Department of Transportation's (FDOT) Safety Performance Targets and agrees to plan and program projects so that they contribute toward the accomplishment of the FDOT HSIP targets.
