## District Five is "Filling in the Gaps"


- 424040-4 East Central Regional Rail Trail (ECRRT)
   US 1 from Kingman Rd to Volusia County Line, 12.8 miles
  - FDOT led (Design—Build)
  - Ribbon Cutting held February 23, 2018
- → 436434-1 Spring to Spring Trail
  from Wayside Park to Lake Monroe, 0.48 miles
  - First SUN Trail funded project in the state
  - FDOT led
  - Completed May 2018
- > 415434-3 and -9 ECRRT in Volusia, 20.2 Miles total (~8.5 miles on Coast to Coast)
  - Local Agency Program (LAP)
  - Led by Volusia County (Design—Build)
  - Ribbon Cutting held September 21, 2018
  - Closes gap on East Coast Greenway, St. Johns River to Sea Loop and Coast to Coast Trail
  - Now, continuous connectivity from Osteen to Edgewater and Osteen to Brevard County

## **SUN Trail Future Funding**

13 ongoing projects programmed

- > 8 projects to be constructed by Fiscal Year 24
  - Adding approximately 17 miles of trail
