#### I. CALL TO ORDER

Chairman Jeffrey Campbell welcomed everyone and called the Community Advisory Committee meeting to order at 9:32 a.m.

#### II. PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

Mr. Jeff Boebinger led the Pledge of Allegiance.

#### III. CHAIRMAN'S COMMENTS

Chairman Campbell detailed the public comment procedures. He told CAC members that at the February board meeting he shared CAC members' concerns regarding the future EV charging stations on I-4. Chairman Campbell reported that the CAC New Member Selection Committee met virtually Monday, February 20<sup>th</sup> and selected five candidates to fill MetroPlan Orlando appointee openings. The proposed candidates will go to the MetroPlan Orlando board for approval at their March 8<sup>th</sup> meeting. Chairman Campbell introduced Ms. Cynthia Lambert to announce the Annual Report sharing competition winner, which was CAC.

#### IV. AGENDA REVIEW

Ms. Mary Ann Horne reminded CAC members that meetings required an in-person quorum and emphasized the importance of RSVPs for the meeting. She introduced Ms. Patricia Mondragon, from the Seminole County Health Dept., who was invited to attend by Ms. Venise White. Ms. Horne reminded CAC members about the Active Transportation Survey, which was open until March 10<sup>th</sup>. She called attention to certificates provided for those who attended the Sunshine Law Refresher at the January meeting. Ms. Horne announced that MetroPlan Orlando staff member, Ms. Sarah Larsen and her husband welcomed a baby boy, James, January 28<sup>th</sup>. She stated there were no changes to the printed agenda, but noted that the full title of the federal grant covered in Ms. Taylor Laurent's presentation was Safe Streets and Roads for All.

#### V. CONFIRMATION OF QUORUM

Ms. Lisa Smith conducted the attendance roll call and confirmed a quorum.

#### VII. ACTION ITEMS

#### A. January 25, 2023 Meeting Minutes

Approval of the meeting minutes for the January 25, 2023 CAC meeting was requested. The minutes were provided.

**MOTION:** Ms. Theo Webster moved for approval of meeting minutes from January 25, 2023. Mr. Jeff Boebinger seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

## B. FDOT Amendment to FY 2022/23 – 2026/27 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP)

Mr. Jason Sartorio, MetroPlan Orlando staff, requested the CAC make a recommendation to the Board that the FY 2022/23 – 2026/27 TIP be amended to include the following items:

 FM# 443548-1 – Fortune Road and Simpson Road Intersection Improvement Project

A letter from FDOT staff explaining the amendment request was included, along with a sheet prepared by MetroPlan Orlando staff and the draft resolution to be presented at the March 8, 2023 Board meeting. Mr. Sartorio gave a brief review of the amendment request. Discussion ensued regarding project cost increase, the impact of the project when complete and the completion date.

**MOTION:** Mr. Tom O'Hanlon moved for approval of the FDOT Amendment to FY 2022/23 – 2026/27 Transportation Improvement Program. Mr. R.J. Mueller seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

#### VIII. PRESENTATIONS & STATUS REPORTS

#### A. Safe Streets and Roads for All Update

Ms. Taylor Laurent, MetroPlan Orlando staff, provided an update on the Safe Streets and Roads for All grant program. MetroPlan Orlando was awarded federal funding to develop regional and local safety action plans. Ms. Laurent told CAC Members that MetroPlan Orlando was awarded \$3.79 million which will be used to create Vision Zero Safety Action Plans for the region, the three counties and 19 cities and towns. She reviewed the anticipated components, what's next for MetroPlan Orlando and what local partners can do. Ms. Laurent noted that the local partners are being asked to designate a region champion who can serve as the point of contact for the project.

#### B. 2021/2022 Traffic Signal Retiming Program

Mr. Eric Hill, MetroPlan Orlando staff, gave a presentation on the Traffic Signal Retiming Program. An infographic outlining the 2022 Corridor Retiming Program was provided. Mr. Hill told committee members that signal retiming is an annual program and he was providing an update on 2022 retiming efforts. He reviewed why signal retiming was important and reported that 17 corridors and 7 independent

intersections were retimed in Orange and Seminole counties. Osceola, he added, did not submit any corridors for retiming for 2022. Mr. Hill provided a history of data sources and noted that Connected Vehicle data went through a validation process. He reviewed the performance metrics, project results, and benefit/cost summary, along with the historic benefit/cost summary. Discussion ensued regarding data from 2021 and 2022, the effect of retiming on cross streets, and air quality emissions data. Members asked for more information on why Osceola County did not submit any corridors for retiming.

#### C. Bicycle/Pedestrian Count Program Status Update

Mr. Mighk Wilson, MetroPlan Orlando, gave a status update on the ongoing tracking and analyzing of bicycle and pedestrian counts around the region. Mr. Wilson provided an overview and history of the Bicycle/Pedestrian Count Program including the technology changes over time. He reviewed the technology changes from people counters to Eco counters to Miovision and detailed the advantages of the current Miovision system. Mr. Wilson outlined MetroPlan Orlando's use of the bicycle/pedestrian counts, the 2023 counts and some examples of types of counts. Discussion ensued regarding how counts relate to roads that could be used by bicyclists and pedestrians, equity and non-equity areas, how data is used and who is using it, and lack of sidewalks in other areas of the country compared to Florida.

#### D. I-4 Beyond the Ultimate Project Update

Ms. Catalina Chacon, FDOT, gave a presentation on the updates to the I-4 Beyond the Ultimate (BtU South) project. Ms. Chacon called attention to the Governor's recent Moving Florida Forward Infrastructure initiative. She provided background on the I-4 Ultimate and Beyond the Ultimate projects, including a map that showed the phased approach for Beyond the Ultimate. She noted that I-4 is the backbone of Central Florida and a top priority. However, funding has been an issue; the phased approach has helped to move projects forward. Ms. Chacon detailed phased projects in Orange and Osceola counties and their status. She told CAC members that a traffic assessment. using heat maps, was conducted to find the focus areas that were most congested. Osceola County, she added, was experiencing severe congestion. Opportunities and a value engineering approach were used to move the Osceola projects forward. Ms. Chacon reviewed what they are proposing for the Osceola projects, including the connections to Orange and Polk counties and the next steps. She provided a brief presentation on Moving Florida Forward, including a map of the 20 projects - 4 of which are in District 5. Discussion ensued regarding barriers being stationary and not dynamic, lack of funding for the BTU north extension, wildlife crossings, cost per mile, where funding is coming from, and the schedule for the I-4/Sand Lake Road project.

#### 432193-5 I-4 Ultimate Terry Avenue Road Project

- Contract T5745
- Project Start: November 2022
- Estimated Completion: Fall 2024
- Update: Contractor is building of a new section of Hicks Avenue between Gore Street and Anderson Street to the north. Crews will also build two roundabouts at the intersections between Hicks Avenue and Carter and Conley streets. New on-street parking and sidewalks are included on the project.

#### 439237-1 & 441146-1 S.R. 535 (Kissimmee-Vineland Road) Resurfacing from south of International Drive to south of Hotel Plaza Boulevard




#### **10-Year Historic Ozone Attainment Status**






#### Air Quality Monitoring: Particulate Matter 2.5 Attainment Status As of April 17, 2023

Subject: April 2023 Bicycle & Pedestrian Activity Update

#### **City of Casselberry**

Construction of the Sunset Drive Livable Street Improvements project is underway, from Button Road to Carriage Hill Drive, narrowing the travel lanes to 10 ft. and providing a 10 ft. shared use path.

The Southcot Drive Bicycle/Pedestrian Improvements project is anticipated to be bid out in the next few weeks.

The City has completed a draft concept update for active transportation improvements to SR 436 between US 17-92 and Wilshire Drive, which could further extend the City's trail network. A public input meeting is scheduled for April 27 from 6:00 - 7:45 p.m. at the Seminole County Public Library located at 215 N Oxford Rd in Casselberry.

#### City of Longwood

The City is wrapping up two complete streets studies; W. Warren Ave. from SR 434 to Milwee St., and E. Church Ave. from Ronald Reagan Blvd. (by the SunRail station) to US 17-92. The E. Church Ave project will be having a public workshop on May 18<sup>th</sup> at the City of Longwood Community Building.

The City is in the design stage for two sidewalk projects, providing sidewalks along Milwee St., W. Warren from SR 434 to Ronald Reagan Blvd., and neighborhood streets such as Maine Ave., Lake Ave. and Reider Ave.
