b. Election of Chairman to Serve the Remainder of 2014 and 2015

Normally, at the last meeting of each calendar year, members of the Central Florida MPO Alliance select one of its officers however recent results of municipal elections in two member jurisdictions have resulted in vacancies of the chair and secretary positions. With only two meetings remaining this calendar year, staff recommends appointment of Council Member Stan McClain (current vice chairman) as chairman for the remainder of the year and 2015.
