At the request of MetroPlan Orlando Board Chairwoman, staff has conducted a review of rapid transit system expansion in 24 metropolitan areas across the United States. Key findings include:

- No two metropolitan areas followed the same steps
- Nearly every metropolitan area has a dedicated local funding source for transit capital expansion and operations
- Securing the dedicated local funding source often included a citizen-approved transit map with list of projects
- Governance and regional structure varied widely when it came to developing and implementing rapid transit map

Elizabeth Whitton, MetroPlan Orlando staff, will present a detailed review of the analysis with a focus on four comparison metropolitan areas – Salt Lake City, Miami-Dade, Norfolk/Virginia Beach, and Raleigh/Durham/Chapel Hill.
