I. CALL TO ORDER

Chairman John Dowless called the meeting to order at 9:31 a.m.

II. PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

Chairman Dowless requested a moment of silence before leading the Pledge of Allegiance.

III. CHAIR'S ANNOUNCEMENTS

Chairman Dowless had no announcements

IV. CONFIRMATION OF QUORUM

Ms. Goldfarb confirmed a quorum was present.

V. AGENDA REVIEW/FOLLOW-UP

Ms. Virginia Whittington congratulated new MAC Officers, Chairman, Council President John Dowless and Vice-Chairman, Mayor Dominic Persampiere. She reported that Ms. Kellie Smith, who had been serving as the interim FDOT District 5 liaison, has been designated the official MetroPlan District 5 liaison. Ms. Whittington noted that Ms. Alison Stettner was in attendance for Ms. Carol Scott, Florida's Turnpike Enterprise. She reported that MetroPlan Orlando's Regional Leadership Council was scheduled to meet July 11, 2017 and the new Chairman and Vice-Chairman participate in those meetings. She called attention to items in the supplemental folders which included a revised PD&E Study update.

VI. PARTNER REPORTS

LYNX

Mr. Doug Robinson, LYNX, reported that the LYNX August service change public meetings were held the week of June 6th. He added that the changes were minor and the service changes made in response to the new terminal opening at Orlando International Airport would be deferred to December. Mr. Robinson told MAC members that LYNX staff will be attending a number of public outreach events for the TDP Route Optimization Study to get the word out and solicit comments.

FDOT

Ms. Kellie Smith, FDOT, told MAC members that the Work Program Public Hearings will be held the week of October 9^{th.} The public hearing will be held online, as well as scheduled at the FDOT district Office on October 10th from 4:30 – 6:30 p.m. She added that it was important that projects be submitted to MetroPlan Orlando in order to get into the Work Program and be programmed by FDOT.

Florida's Turnpike Enterprise

Ms. Alison Stettner, Florida's Turnpike Enterprise (FTE), reported that a design public meeting will be held on August 22nd for the Turnpike Mainline project from US 192 to Osceola Parkway. The public hearing will also include a new ramp for Southbound US 192.

Mr. Doug Robinson added that LYNX would be happy to provide outreach on the TDP Route Optimization Study at any local events MAC members might be aware of.

A. Approval of June 8, 2017 Meeting Minutes

B. FY 2017/18 - 2021/22 Transportation Improvement Program

Action was requested by Mr. Keith Caskey, MetroPlan Orlando staff, to recommend approval of the FY 2017/18 - 2021/22 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). This document included the transportation projects in the MetroPlan Orlando region that are programmed for funding over the next five years. The draft TIP was provided. A fact sheet on the TIP, the TIP public hearing summary and the draft TIP approval resolution for the July 12th Board meeting were also provided. Mr. Caskey told MAC members that he previewed the TIP at the June meeting and was now asking for approval.

MOTION:

Mayor Gary Bruhn moved for approval of the FY 2017/18 - 2021/22 Transportation Improvement Program. Mayor Dale McDonald seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

C. FY 2022/23 - 2039/40 Prioritized Project List

Action was requested by Mr. Nick Lepp, MetroPlan Orlando staff, to recommend approval of the FY 2022/23 - 2039/40 Prioritized Project List (PPL). This document included a list of highway, transportation systems management and operations, bicycle and pedestrian, and transit projects that have been ranked in order of priority. FDOT will use the PPL in developing their FY 2018/19-2022/23 Five Year Work Program. The draft PPL and a fact sheet were provided. Mayor Durso asked about the time frame for the SR434/SR427 intersection project as there is development planned in the southwest corner of that area. Mr. Lepp responded that he would research that information for Mayor Durso. Mayor Bruhn asked about the Old Winter Garden Road extension. Commissioner Keller responded that the project is in the Comp Plan for City of Ocoee.

A. Presentation on Transportation Systems Management & Operations (TSMO) Activities

Ms. Crystal Mercedes, MetroPlan Orlando staff, gave a presentation on the latest Transportation Systems Management and Operations (TSMO) activities underway in the MetroPlan Orlando region. Ms. Mercedes reviewed information on the Crash Database, Signal Retiming efforts, and Congestion Management strategies. Discussion ensued regarding Best Foot Forward education outreach efforts, coordinated efforts with police departments for Best Foot Forward, and the number of retimed roadways. Ms. Mercedes reported that at this time over 50% of the roadways identified had been retimed. Mayor McDonald requested that US 17/92 North and South be looked at for signal retiming.
