### **Confidentiality of Quotes**

#### **Proprietary Information:**

"In accordance with Chapter 119 of the Florida Statutes (Public Records Act), and except as may be provided by other applicable State and Federal Law, all responders should be aware that Requests for Quotes and the responses thereto are in the public domain. However, the responders are requested to **identify specifically** any information contained in their Quotes which they consider confidential and/or proprietary and which they believe to be exempt from disclosure, citing specifically the applicable exempting law."

Please note that Sections 119.07(3)(m) of the Florida Statutes address in part the issue of the public nature of sealed bids or Quotes as well as the non-public nature of certain trade secrets. The Quote submitted by your company may contain areas, which are designated "confidential" or "exempt from disclosure." If your Quote contains such information you are required to advise MetroPlan Orlando with specificity the applicable law making those provisions exempt from disclosure in accordance with the Public Records Law. A generic notation that information is "confidential" will not suffice.

Failure to provide the Department of Finance and Administration with a detailed explanation and justification including statutory cites and specific reference to your bid package detailing what provisions, if any, you believe are exempt from disclosure, may result in your Quote being subject to disclosure in accordance with Chapter 119 of the Florida Statutes.
