

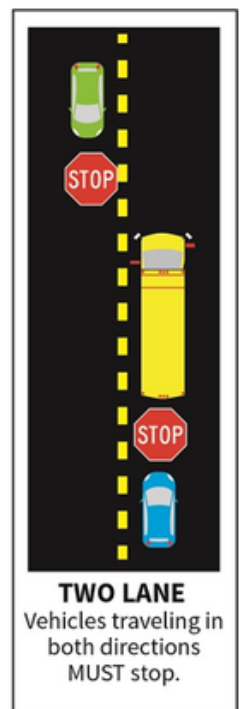
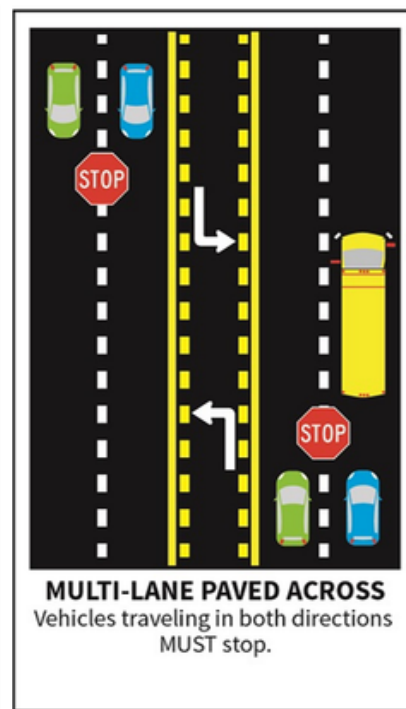
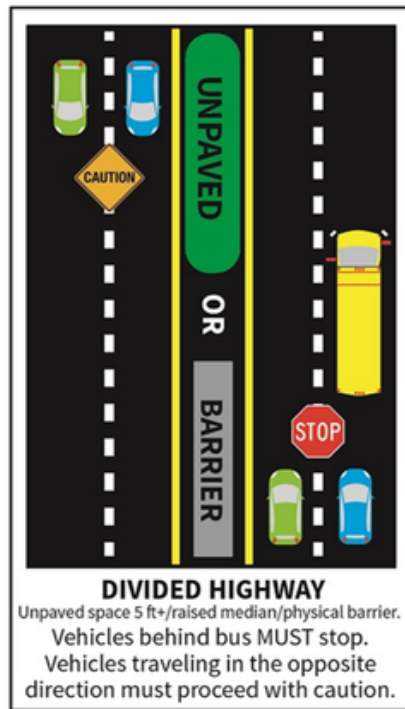
SAFETY MOMENT: SCHOOL BUS SAFETY

MOTORISTS ARE **REQUIRED TO STOP WHEN APPROACHING A SCHOOL BUS THAT IS STOPPED WITH ITS RED LIGHTS FLASHING AND STOP ARMS EXTENDED**

THE CAMERON MAYHEW ACT TOOK EFFECT IN 2017

Increases minimum penalty for drivers who illegally pass a stopped school bus, resulting in **injury or **death** of another person.**

PENALTIES INCLUDE:

- 120 community service hours in trauma center or hospital
- Participation in victim's impact panel session or FLHSMV approved driver improvement course
- Six points on driver's license
- Suspension of license for a minimum of one year
- \$1,500 fine
