I. Call to Order - Chairman Hazem El-Assar

Chairman Hazem El-Assar called the TSMO Advisory Committee meeting to order at 1:30 p.m.

V. Consent Agenda

A. Approval of the April 24, 2015 TSMO Meeting Minutes

Approval was requested of the April 24, 2015 meeting minutes provided.

MOTION: Mr. Jay Davoll moved approval of the April 24, 2015 TSMO Meeting Agenda. Mr.

Ramon Senorans seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

VI. Action Items

A. FY 2015/16-2019/20 Transportation Improvement Program

Action was requested by Mr. Keith Caskey, MetroPlan Orlando staff, to recommend approval of the FY 2015/16-2019/20 TIP. This document includes the transportation projects in the MetroPlan Orlando region that are programmed for funding over the next five years. A copy of the draft TIP was provided. A copy of the FY 2019/20-2039/40 PPL that was adopted last year and has been updated to show the latest project phases that have been funded based on the new TIP was also provided. An updated list of Osceola County projects and the June 22, 2015 Public Hearing comments were also provided at the meeting.

Mr. Hazem El-Assar requested more information on the details of the UCF Big Data project scope; Ms. Schoelzel will follow-up on this request. He also asked about any additional SU funding to help with the shortfall of funding for the retiming projects. Ms. Schoelzel noted that currently there are no additional funding but will follow-up with Mr. El-Assar to confirm. Mr. Hill called attention to Mr. Bob O'Malley's TIP Public Hearing Comments where he recommended improved traffic signalization on SR 414.

MOTION: Mr. Jay Davoll moved approval of the FY 2015/16-2019/20 Transportation

Improvement Program. Ms. Joedel Zaballero seconded the motion, which passed

unanimously.

B. Traffic Signal Retiming List FY 2015/16

Action was requested by Mr. Eric Hill, MetroPlan Orlando staff, to recommend approval of FY 2015/16 Signal Retiming list. Staff coordinated with local jurisdictions that are responsible for traffic signal maintenance and operation to develop the list, which will be used by the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) consultants to implement traffic signal timing plans. A revised list was provided at the meeting and sent electronically in advance of the

meeting to members. Members re-evaluated the revised list that was provided at the meeting that included additional revisions to the jurisdiction list and program allocations for the FY 2015/16 Signal Retiming list. A copy of the final list is attached as the official record.

MOTION: Ms. Joedel Zaballero moved approval of the revised FY 2015/16 Signal Retiming list with the recommended changes (attached). Mr. Cade Braud seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

A. Status Report on Re-adoption of 2040 LRTP

Mr. Gary Huttmann, MetroPlan Orlando staff, presented a status report on the process for the re-adoption later this year of the 2040 Long Range Transportation Plan. The presentation included the purpose and the schedule for the (Re)adoption process that is scheduled for board approval in December 2015.

B. Presentation on CFX Commuter Relief Program & 2040 Master Plan

Mr. Glenn Pressimone, Central Florida Expressway Authority (CFX), presented the CFX Commuter Relief Program and 2040 Master Plan. CFX is conducted a survey for their 2040 Master Plan which was provided via a weblink. Discussion followed relative to the integration of national transponders and connected vehicles.

C. Presentation on Bicycle & Pedestrian Count Program (Taken Out of Order as Item: A)

Ms. Gabriella Arismendi, MetroPlan Orlando staff, presented the technology that is being used to gather data on the number of people that ride bicycles and walk in the MetroPlan Orlando area. Mr. Kelly Brock suggested that staff consider weather data.
